## Learn Innovative Engagement Techniques

The World Café method is a consultation and ideas generation methodology. It is designed to create a safe, welcoming environment in which to intentionally connect multiple ideas and perspectives on a topic by engaging participants in several rounds of small-group conversations.

The World Café method is particularly useful when you want to be sure to explore a topic from multiple perspectives, to ensure that everyone in a room contributes in a conversation, and/or when you want to encourage participants to make new connections. It is useful if you have a large group of people (over 10) who you need to consult with or have involved in a co-design process.

It provides the foundations for real actions

- Projects to progress
- Content for grant applications
- Other methods for progressing ideas
- One part of a co-design process involving a large group of people

This workshop will first teach the World Café methodology so participants are confident in the facilitation techniques required to make a World Café session a success. Then participants will be part of a World Café where they will be able to explore a range of topics which are important to them.

The engagement and brainstorming with diverse groups will provide innovative ideas that can be applied to many different topics. It will help you clarify your purpose and be more innovative!
